Terms & Conditions – Surf Education Programmes

Weather conditions

Beach Ed will not be cancelled if it rains; we have a wet weather programme at the clubs.

Programme/session times

Beach Ed starts at 9.30am and ends at approximately 2.30pm, if you wish to end earlier to be back at school by 3pm please discuss with the instructor on the day.

Surf to School sessions are either 45-60 minutes for theory or 90 minutes for theory and pool. We take a maximum of 2 classes in a theory session and one or two classes for the pool session depending on pool size. We suggest the theory only for year 0-4 and full theory & pool session for year 5-8. We can schedule 4-5 theory sessions or 3 theory & pool sessions in a school day or a combination of theory and theory & pool sessions.

Parent/Teacher Ratios – Beach Education

Parents and teachers are expected to participate in both water and beach activities.

The programme requires a minimum of 1 adult to every 5 students in the water. It is essential that parents & teachers bring their togs and be prepared to get wet. It is a good idea for parent helpers to bring wetsuits if they have them.

Poolside Supervision – Surf to School

With the Surf to School pool sessions the lifeguards will be teaching the students in the pool while the teacher is required to cover the poolside supervision.

First Aid

We also ask that each group designates a suitably qualified parent or teacher to be responsible for minor first aid situations so that our instructors are not distracted from their teaching. Of course, our qualified instructors will immediately attend to any first aid of an urgent or serious nature.

Payment

Beach Ed & Surf to School invoices will be issued after you have attended the programme. Schools will be invoiced according to how many students were booked onto the Beach Ed programme. If a greater number of students attended on the day your invoice will be adjusted accordingly.

Cancellations

If a booking is cancelled within 3 weeks of your booking date 50% of the total bill will be invoiced, this will be based on the number of students specified by the school at the time of the initial booking. If your booking is cancelled within 48 hours of the booking date you will be invoiced the total bill.

Natural Disasters

All of our beach education days will go ahead as planned unless civil defence implements a tsunami or coastal warning. In the event of a tsunami or coastal warning from civil defence on the day, the day will be cancelled and you will not be charged. Schools may reschedule their booking via mutual agreement.

Minimum booking numbers & costs

SLSNZ have a strict minimum booking number of 30 students to cover our costs. We do not book numbers of less than 30. If you attend with less than 30 students you will still be invoiced for and required to pay for 30 students.

Pricing changes

If a price increase occurs you will be charged at the price of the original booking however, if you wish to change the booking date the new price applies.
